Job Description: Sports Coordinator

Training Dates: July 2nd to July 5th

Start Date: July 8th **End Date:** August 15th

Hours Per Week: 35-40 Hours (Tentative: Monday to Friday, 8:30 AM – 3:30PM)

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Description:

The Sports Co-ordinator will conduct sessions lasting approximately 1 hour with campers geared towards physical fitness and sports. They will be responsible for designing a daily curriculum lasting the duration of the camp (6 weeks) prior to the start of the camp and creating a list of equipment that must be purchased for such activities. Daily sessions should incorporate stretches, followed by a warm-up game, and then a main activity for the day. The Sports Co-ordinator will be expected to adhere to this curriculum.

The Sports and Leisure Co-ordinator will be responsible for ensuring that all activities and games played are safe for campers to participate in. They are expected to instruct campers on how to perform the physical activities they assign, explain any rules/regulations, and will curate the activities for each age group.

The Sports and Leisure Co-ordinator will collaborate with the Leadership Team to develop a simple curriculum for campers and counsellors to follow along with. This role is crucial to the overall purpose of the TARIC Summer Day Camp, which is to provide campers with a fun summer experience in an Islamic environment.

Ideal Candidates:

The ideal candidate is someone who:

- Has a background in the Kinesiology and Health Science field as well as a background in working with children.
- Can effectively communicate and explain rules/activities to younger campers in simple terms.
- Is able to gauge safety and appropriateness of activities.
- Maintains authority over campers.
- Demonstrates punctuality and a good sense of time.
- Participates in sports and athletics.
- Makes activities and games fun for all campers regardless of age or gender.
- Be fluent in reading Arabic.
